

COTOPAXI FULL DAY TOUR



One of the most beautiful snow-capped volcanoes in Ecuador, Cotopaxi Volcano reaches an altitude of 5,897 meters (19,388 feet) and is considered the highest active volcano in the world.

We will depart from Quito at 8:00 AM, traveling south along the Pan-American Highway. After approximately two hours, we will arrive at Cotopaxi National Park.

During the journey, passengers will enjoy spectacular landscapes of the Ecuadorian Andes. Once inside the park, we will visit the park museum to learn about the local flora and fauna, as well as important information about the impressive Cotopaxi Volcano.

Afterward, we will take a short 30-minute walk and then continue to Limpiopungo Lagoon, where we will enjoy a delicious snack while admiring the surrounding natural scenery.

Next, we will drive to the parking area at 4,600 meters above sea level. For those passengers seeking a bit more adventure and adrenaline, there is the option to hike for about one hour to the José Rivas Refuge, located at 4,800 meters above sea level. Reaching the refuge is a rewarding experience and a highlight of the visit.

After descending, we will begin our return journey to Quito, arriving at approximately 5:00 PM.
