

MINDO FULL DAY TOUR



We will begin the journey at 8:00 AM, traveling northwest of Quito. Our first stop will be the viewpoint of Pululahua Volcano, where passengers can enjoy spectacular views of one of the few inhabited volcanic craters in the world.

Next, we will visit the Pahuma Orchid Reserve, a protected 1,500-acre tropical montane forest. Here, we will learn about some of the more than 200 orchid species identified in the reserve. During the visit, we will also enjoy a short walk to a beautiful waterfall.

Once we arrive in Mindo, passengers will visit the Mariposas de Mindo Butterfly Garden, where more than 25 species of butterflies native to the region can be observed.

Continuing the tour, we will visit Nambillo Waterfall. To reach it, we will first cross the impressive Mindo River canyon using a tarabita (cable car) that stretches approximately 530 meters across the valley. Once on the other side, we will enjoy a pleasant walk down to the river and waterfall.

After this adventure, we will enjoy a delicious lunch at a first-class restaurant, where we can also admire several species of hummingbirds, which are commonly seen in this area.

Following lunch and some time to relax, we will begin our return journey to Quito, arriving at approximately 5:00 PM.

Passengers may also choose to experience canopy (zip-line) activities during the visit; however, this activity is not included in the tour price.
