

QUILOTOA FULL DAY TOUR



Quilotoa Lagoon is a stunning volcanic crater lake approximately 3 km in diameter. Its striking emerald-green waters and perfectly rounded shape make it easily recognizable, even from the air. On a clear day, it is possible to spot the lagoon from a commercial flight approaching Quito from the south.

We will depart from Quito and travel toward Quilotoa, a fascinating natural attraction formed inside the crater of an extinct volcano with a remarkable geological history.

Depending on the day of the week, we will also visit one of the region's traditional indigenous markets:

- Latacunga (Tuesday and Saturday)
- Pujilí (Wednesday and Sunday)
- Saquisilí (Thursday)

At these authentic local markets, visitors will have the opportunity to see and purchase a wide variety of handicrafts, including leather goods, pottery, ceramics, wood carvings, leather paintings, paper and wooden masks, and traditional textiles made from totora, cabuya, wool, and straw.

We will then continue our journey to Quilotoa Lagoon, where we will enjoy a traditional lunch.

After lunch, we will descend toward the lagoon for a scenic walk, allowing time to admire the breathtaking landscape and take photographs of this extraordinary natural wonder.

Later, we will begin our return journey to Quito, with the possibility of stopping along the way to visit some symbolic attractions of the region before arriving back in the city.
