ITINERARY:

Day 1 – Arrival & First Encounter with the Jungle

- Your adventure begins at **Pusuno Bajo River**, where a guided hike takes you to **Suchipakari Amazon Lodge**, an ecolodge surrounded by pristine rainforest.
- Upon arrival, enjoy a **tropical welcome cocktail** and a delicious lunch prepared with local ingredients.
- Begin with an **introductory jungle walk**, where expert guides will explain the use of medicinal plants and local wildlife.
- In the afternoon, relax while floating down the river in a refreshing **Amazonian tubing experience**.
- After dinner, embark on a **night walk under the stars**: frogs, insects, nocturnal birds, and the mysterious sounds of the jungle will surround you.
- Overnight stay immersed in the natural sounds of the tropical forest.

Day 2-A – Napo River, Kichwa Culture & Wildlife

- Start the day with an **Amazonian breakfast**, followed by a motorized canoe ride along the **Napo River**, home to monkeys, toucans, and macaws.
- Visit the **Amazoonico Wildlife Rescue Center**, where you will encounter species such as ocelots, macaws, and monkeys in rehabilitation.
- Continue to a **local Kichwa community**, where you will learn about ancestral traditions, cassava chicha preparation, blowgun hunting techniques, and traditional dances.
- End the day with a magical **caiman observation at Anaconda Island**, a stunning natural experience at sunset.
- Dinner and overnight at **Suchipakari Lodge**.

Day 2-B – Waterfalls & Hidden Nature

- Breakfast
- Transfer to **Umbuni River** to explore primary and secondary forest trails guided by an expert naturalist. Discover medicinal plants, exotic insects, and vibrant birdlife.
- Trek to a **hidden waterfall** deep within the rainforest.
- Enjoy a **picnic lunch by the river**.
- In the afternoon, visit **Monkey Beach in Puerto Misahuallí**.
- Cross the Napo River to visit **Kawana Lagoon**, where you will paddle by canoe through a natural sanctuary and observe giant paiche fish, sloths, capuchin monkeys, toucans, and tropical birds.
- Return to the lodge.
- In the evening, enjoy a **candlelit dinner**, and optionally relax with a massage or in your Amazon suite overlooking the forest.
